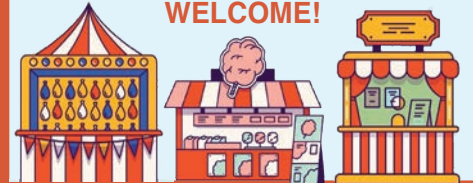

Have you ever wanted to support someone who was grieving the loss of a loved one, navigating a difficult diagnosis, or facing another life-altering hardship, but found yourself at a loss for words? Or maybe you've said something in the moment, only to later think, *"I wish I hadn't said that."*

Trauma Care, also known as **"Healing Conversations,"** is a focused, impactful training designed to help you navigate these difficult moments with compassion, grace, and confidence. Through this training, you'll learn:

- What to say—and what not to say—in sensitive situations
- How to ask meaningful, open-ended questions using a simple three-step framework
- What it means to truly listen, and how to identify and overcome your personal obstacles to being fully present in conversations

You may wonder, *"Why is this important?"*

As the Body of Christ, we are called to walk alongside those who are hurting. Mental health matters, not just emotionally, but relationally, physically, intellectually, and most importantly, spiritually. When we care for others in their pain, we offer them a glimpse of Christ's love. In doing so, we build authentic relationships and create natural opportunities to share the Gospel.
